Program Learning Outcomes (PLOs):

1. Students will demonstrate the ability to apply Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) to the processing and reporting of an entity’s business transactions.
2. Students will demonstrate the ability to initiate the process of critically evaluating a decision-making situation, within an accounting context.
3. Students will obtain an understanding of the requirements of obtaining, and maintaining, Accounting-related professional certifications (CPA, CMA, etc.)
4. Students will demonstrate an awareness of current issues affecting the Accounting profession.
5. Students will assimilate an understanding of the importance of maintaining integrity throughout their professional careers.
6. Students will be able to apply accounting concepts learned to “real world settings”
