Getting a Driver's License

If you are a visitor in Ohio over 18 and have a valid driver license from se as long as your home state license remains valid.

Getting Insurance

Driving Test

There are two parts to the driving test: the road test and the maneuverability test. You will need to schedule the test either online or calling (614)752-7600. You can find detailed information [here](#).

Once You Pass

The BMV will issue you an interim license you can use until you receive your new photo license by mail. This license is valid for 60 days.

If You Fail

Applicants who fail the knowledge test must wait at least 24 hours before retesting. There is no limit on how many times the knowledge test can be taken.

ID Cards

The BMV issues ID cards to persons of any age. The ID card looks like a driver license, but is used for identification purposes only.
