COUNSELING COURSE DESCRIPTIONS (pg. 38)

COU 610. TREATMENT OF EMOTIONAL AND MENTAL DISORDERS (3 sem. hrs.) Students will review evidence-based and emerging treatment interventions for mental and emotional disorders. Students will be able to provide rationale and cite research which supports their choice of a particular intervention for use with a given problem area, population, age group, or cultural group. Additional students will be provided with a basic introduction to psychopharmacology and the use of drugs by medical doctors when treating mental and emotional disorders.
