## HYPE Career Ready Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is required for graduation if I'm a transfer?**

If you transfer in as a sophomore, you will need 26 Units: eight 100-level, twelve 200-level, three 300-level, and three 400-level.

If you transfer in as a junior, you will need 12 Units: three 100-level, six 200-level, three 300-level, or three 400-level.

Students who transferred in as a Senior may request an exemption from the program by emailing [hype@heidelberg.edu](mailto:hype@heidelberg.edu).

### **How do I pick my HYPE Sessions?**

The Catalog of HYPE Sessions will be available on Inside Heidelberg. You can also search on OASIS for Speakers (pre-fix SPKR) and Sessions (pre-fix HYPE). Talk to your advisor to ensure that you are selecting HYPE Sessions that fulfill your HYPE Plan.

### **What happens if I miss a HYPE Session?**

Students should complete two HYPE Units each HYPE Day in their first and second years to stay on track. However, there is the opportunity to earn up to four each day. If you miss an entire HYPE Day, work with your advisor to schedule extra sessions on future HYPE Days to get caught up.

### **What should I do if I want to go on a HYPE trip, but it conflicts with my athletic schedule?**

HYPE Sessions are an important part of your graduation requirements! If you talk to your coach ahead of time, you won't have any problems missing a practice.

### **How do I get credit for HYPE Sessions?**

Attendance is taken at all sessions and keynote speakers. You cannot earn credit for sessions you are not registered for, regardless of attendance.
