COVID-19 vaccinations have reached 44.3% of the U.S. population with at least one dose and 31.6% are fully vaccinated. Ohio vaccinations have reached 40.3% with at least one dose and 33.0% have been fully vaccinated. Meanwhile, the Ohio COVID 7-day running positivity rate has declined to 3.8% and our Seneca County remains on Red Alert with a 7-day positivity rate of 3.7%.
