#### **ELIGIBILITY**

All full-time students are eligible for care and treatment at the health center regardless of their health insurance. All students are required to have a medical history form on file at the health center. Heidelberg health center is able to provide student physical examinations for graduate school, employment of international travel

#### **SERVICES**

- Walk-in health clinic (pharmaceutical & nursing services)
- Counseling services
- Disability accommodations

#### **MEDICATIONS**

In stock or over-the-counter medications may be charged to the student's account. Insurance/drug cards are not accepted at the health center. Students may also choose to have prescriptions filled at a local pharmacy such as Kroger, Wal-Mart, CVS, Medicine Shoppe or Rite Aid.

#### REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS

- Diphtheria/tetanus booster-received within the past 10 years.
- Measles, mumps and rubella-1 initial (early childhood) and 1 booster (childhood)
- Oral polio-3-4 doses (childhood)
- Tuberculosis test (mantoux test)-administered within the last 6 months prior to arrival at Heidelberg University if the t.b. screen questionnaire is positive
- History of chickenpox disease or varicella vaccine
- Hepatitis b vaccine-series of 3 doses (series can be completed at the health center)
- The following immunizations are recommended:
- Meningococcal vaccine
- Influenza vaccine annually
