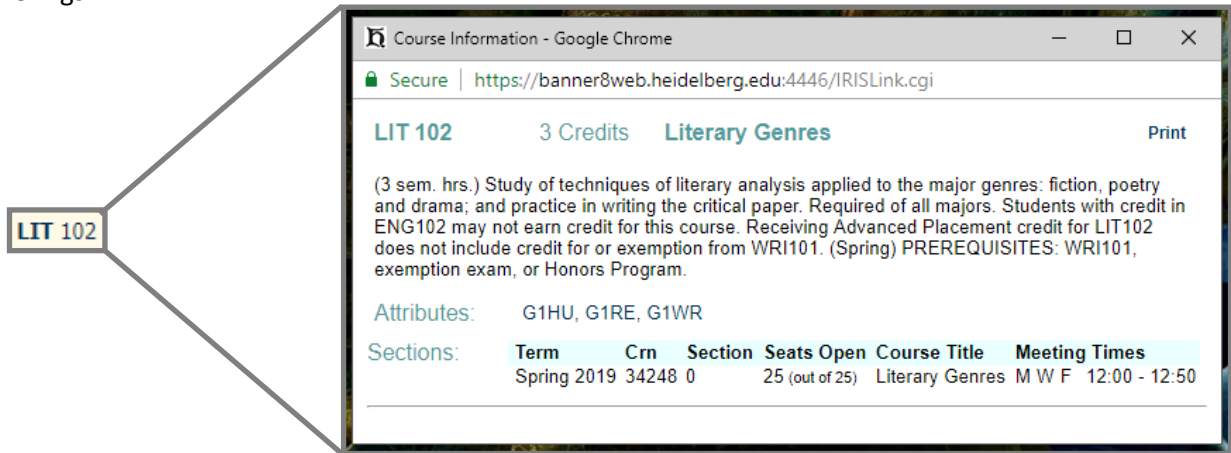
COMPLETION COLOR CODING
